LEVEL 1: THE BLACK BORDER PATCH – Every Scout who turns in 4 or more 13-gallon bags OR copier boxes of donations between NOW and Oct. 31st will receive a Black Border Patch.



LEVEL 2: THE SILVER BORDER UNIT PATCH & PIZZA PARTY – Every participating Scout in THE TROOP with the most donated bags or boxes over all other TROOPS from NOW through Oct. 31st will earn a Silver Border Patch and a PIZZA PARTY.



LEVEL 3: THE GOLD BORDER DISTRICT PATCH – Every participating Scout in THE COMMUNITY with the most donated bags or boxes over all other COMMUNITIES from NOW through Oct. 31st will earn a Gold Border Patch.



TOP HONORS – Any individual Scout can earn a Gold Patch and Service Champion Rocker by collecting 25 or more bags.

GRAND PRIZE!!

The individual Scout who brings in the most bags or copier boxes of donations between NOW and Oct. 31st over all other Scouts will receive a Prize Packet: A pizza party, St. Augustine Alligator Farm Family 4-Pack, \$50 Gift Certificate, Special Letter of Recognition, Certificate of Appreciation, A GOLD PATCH and SERVICE CHAMPION PATCH.

How to Collect Donations

- Collect items from family, friends and neighbors. FLYERS are available at GoodwillJax.org.
- Take each 13-gallon bag or copier box of donations, along with your DONATION FORM to any Goodwill Store or Donation Center. Multiple visits are allowed. Visit GoodwillJax.org for a list of all stores and donation sites.
- Download a DONATION FORM in the Good Turn for Goodwill section under the COMMUNITY tab and fill it out with your name, troop number, troop leader and number of bags or boxes turned in that day. Tell the Donation Center attendant that you are participating in the Girl Scouts: Good Turn for Goodwill program and have the donation attendant sign the DONATION FORM.
- Give your copy of the DONATION FORM to your Troop Leader.

TROOP LEADERS -- TURN IN YOUR PATCH ORDER NO LATER THAN Nov. 15th: To find the link, go to GoodwillJax.org and click on the Girl Scouts Good Turn for Goodwill in the Community section to submit your information in the online form. Winners will be announced in the Dec. 2016 eBlast.
